4.	FIRST AID MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Environmental precautions:

Clean-up methods:

Do not allow product to enter sewer or waterways.

Remove all sources of ignition. Evacuate and ventilate spill area; dike spill to prevent entry into water system; wear full protective equipment during cleanup. Soak up with inert absorbent material (e.g. sand, silica gel, acid binder, universal binder, sawdust). Scrape up as much material as possible.
